

Stanislaus County faces a large job gap.

Stanislaus County's workforce is approximately 231,100 people. Yet, only 176,200 of those are able to earn their salary or wage within the county. That means the county has a shortage of 54,900 jobs for its workforce.

As a result, more than 35,000 Stanislaus County residents are forced to commute outside the county for work each day. In addition, nearly 20,000 local residents are unable to find work, creating an unemployment rate that is nearly twice as high as the statewide average.

West Park will create tens of thousands of jobs in Stanislaus County, providing meaningful employment opportunities for local residents and helping to close this job gap.
